- Blend: 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 8% Syrah, 4% Mourvèdre
- From our 2000 acre estate vineyard in Washington's Horse Heaven Hills AVA
- Aging: neutral oak barrels for 18 months
- Color: deep garnet
- Aromas: raspberry and blueberry jam with hints of violet and cinnamon
- Flavors: rich blackberry, mocha and currant
- Finish: silky with balanced tannins
- Pairing: this is a great food wine – enjoy it with a Texas brisket style BBQ sandwich or vegetable stew
- Technical information: 14.8% alcohol; 1041 cases produced; 0.58 TA; 3.97 pH
