

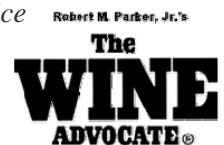


2004 CABERNET SAUVIGNON



- Blend of the original “old block”, planted in 1980, and newer block 17 on our 2000 acre estate vineyard in Washington’s Horse Heaven Hills AVA
- Grapes: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon and 8% Petit Verdot
- Aging: 21 months in new oak barrels (80% French; 20% American)
- Color: garnet red
- Aromas: black fruit with cherry and chocolate
- Flavors: ripe raspberry, chocolate covered cherry and hint of spice
- Finish: balanced with dusty tannins
- Pairing: enjoy with fatty cowboy Ribeye steak right off the grill or pasta with tomato sauce
- Technical information: 14.5% alcohol; 729 cases produced; 0.51 TA; 3.65 pH
