- Blend: 77% Chenin Blanc and 23% Viognier
- From our 2000 acre estate vineyard in Washington's Horse Heaven Hills AVA
- Fermentation: stainless steel tanks
- Aging: sur lie in stainless steel with a small portion of the Chenin Blanc in new oak for structure and richer mouthfeel
- Color: brilliant yellow
- Aromas: ripe apricot, tangerine and lavender with white flowers
- Flavors: lemon lime citrus, orange zest and juicy, ripe pineapple
- Finish: smooth; a nice, long mouthfeel with the perfect touch of acidity
- Pairing: sushi or Thai food
- Technical information: 14.8% alcohol; 1.5% RS; 384 cases produced; 0.63 TA; 3.48 pH
