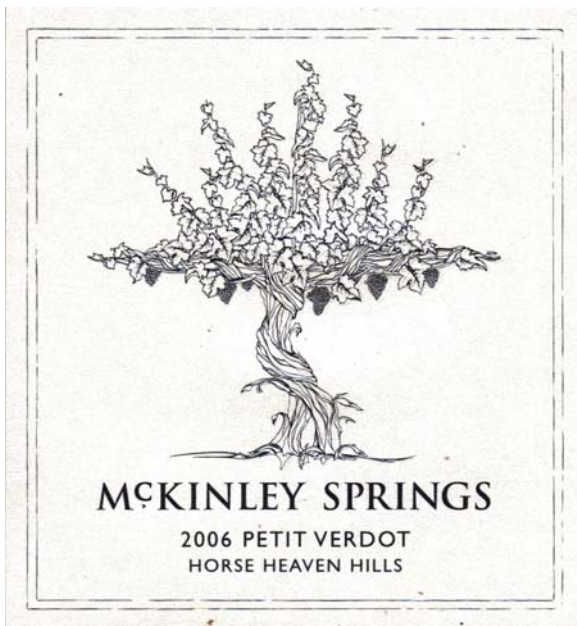




## 2006 PETIT VERDOT

Typically blended with Cabernet Sauvignon to add deep color, this wine was outstanding on its own so we bottled it as a single variety.



- From our 2000 acre estate vineyard in Washington's Horse Heaven Hills
  - Aging: 19 months 100% Alain Fouquet French oak barrels
  - Color: deep purple; nearly black
  - Aromas: black fruit, gingerbread and some earthy and herbal notes
  - Flavors: blackberry jam, Marion berry and a hint of smoked meats
  - Finish: well structured and refined
