- Aromas: coffee bean and dark fruit with a hint of rosemary
- Flavors: rich blackberry, mocha and currant
- Finish: long and dry with balanced tannins
- Pairing: this is a great food wine – enjoy it with a Texas brisket style BBQ sandwich or vegetable stew
