- Blend of the original “old block”, planted in 1980, and newer block 17 on our 2000 acre estate vineyard in Washington’s Horse Heaven Hills AVA
- Grapes: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon and 8% Petit Verdot
- Aging: 23 months in 50% new oak barrels (75% French; 25% American)
- Color: garnet red
- Aromas: sage brush, cinnamon, and earthy notes.
- Flavors: dark black cherry fruit, dark chocolate raspberry truffle, and hint of spice.
- Finish: balanced with dusty tannins
- Pairing: enjoy with fatty cowboy Ribeye steak right off the grill or pasta with tomato sauce
- Technical information: 14.6% alcohol; 419 cases produced; .65 TA, 3.85 pH.
