- Color: deep purple; nearly black
- Aromas: black fruit, gingerbread and some earthy and herbal notes
- Flavors: blackberry jam, Marion berry and a hint of smoked meats
- Finish: well structured and refined
- Pairing: pork spare ribs, hearty casserole or mature cheeses
